Located rue de Seine in the center of Saint Germain des Prés, the Arcturus Gallery opened in 1999, led by the passion of Anne de la Roussière, who was a former bank professional.

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An air of surrealism in the implementation of comical from everyday objects at Peter ZUPNIK

Born in 1961 in Levoca (Slovakia). In the years 1976-1980 he studied photography to the High School of Art and Craft of Kosice. From 1981 to 1986 he pursued graduate studies in art photography at the renowned University FAMU in Prague. Since 1988 he is member of Most Visual Arts Group, and develops a work imbued with a very personal poetry of the absurd and a typically slavic humor. He is considered by Daniela Mrázková, as one of the most important photographers out of the FAMU in the 80s (cf. Paris Photo, No. 11, November-December 2000).

«By capturing the reality in live with the photographic technique, Zupnik Peter has created a reservoir of images whose he draws the present and future visions. His themes, these are faces, animals, objects, plants, buildings and fruits. His method is to particularize the banality... It gives clear priority within the model as it is for him an original poetic depiction. He wants to create another reality and find the secret of space and time.»

An air of surrealism in the gap between banality and strangeness of the context at Richard KALVAR

Born in Brooklyn, New York in 1944. After studying English and American literature at Cornell University from 1961 to 1965, Richard Kalvar worked in New York as an assistant to photographer Jérôme Ducrot. It was an extended trip with a camera in Europe in 1966 that made him decide to become a photographer. After two years in New York he settled in Paris and joined the first Vu photo agency, and then in 1972 he helped found the Viva agency. In 1975, he became an associate member of Magnum Photos, and a full member two years later. He has since served as vice-president and president of the agency. He has photographed extensively in the US, Europe and Japan.

« I start making pictures in one place when I detect something vaguely interesting. I turn around, looking for something, I do not know what exactly. Often there is no point. But sometimes the unexpected or inspiration occurs suddenly, and so I am lucky because I have the camera to the eye, I can capture this moment. There is nothing premeditated or predetermined...

I take people for actors unwittingly involved in my little fictional scenes

This is actually the story that the viewer can imagine that most interests me, especially when it is a story somewhat ambiguous. The picture crystallizes a moment in the unfolding of time, it is for me the essence of photography. I love this capture, "freezing" a moment in the picture. »

An air of surrealism in designing invented and manufactured landscapes at Didier MASSARD.

Born in Paris in 1953. After working with Henri Langlois at the Cinémathèque française he developed a career as a professional photographer in the field of still life, landscape and architecture. From 1993 he began a series of more personal works based on the design and construction of miniature sets entirely designed and photographed in the studio.

Since 1998 he devoted himself exclusively to this work, and his pictures are exhibited in France and abroad. They are present in many private and public collections.

*“These photographs are all **mirabilia**, things to watch in wonder and in fearless admiration. These timeless places, the geographical imprecision, refer to a naive world where supernatural is established. Certainly one will find number of pictorial references, first and foremost the german Romanticism and more particularly that of Caspar David Friedrich, whose many recurring themes are explicitly mentioned here and there...”*


