The ARCTURUS gallery presents photographs by Julien DRACH for the first time, as of Decembre 8, 2020.

In this series « Still life Polaroid » the starting point of each shot is a staging inspired by a beautiful set of Italian vases found by the artist, against a background of his own photos of abstract walls that evoke paintings; walls marked by the erosion of time and of course Italy, one of the photographer's primary sources of inspiration, reinforced by the artist's residency at the Villa Medici in the fall of 2018.

This original combination of a photo within a photo is part of his continuous search of the poetic image, a fragile and mysterious light, a moment of eternity. The atmosphere of the Polaroid print is inherently blurry and has an enigmatic light. By choosing to work on the Polaroid negative, Julien Drach manages to obtain larger print sizes.

Raised on film sets, Julien Drach began his career as an actor. Passionate about images and light, he then moved onto photography, through his delicate shots he reveals the hidden and sometimes even invisible part of things, of beings, and captures a certain nostalgia.
